

## DAY TWO: DOWNTOWN + CHANNELSIDE

Pronounced KEE-KEE-REE-KEE; Spanish for the call of a rooster and a nod to the free-roaming roosters of Ybor City, Cafe Quiquiriqui is a chic Cuban-European inspired cafe that transports diners to another time and place. Sit and enjoy a café con leche featuring locally roasted MADE Coffee, purchase a custom-made cigar and snack from a menu of house-made bites.

Tampa Bay's TECO Historic Streetcar Line links downtown, the Channel District and the Ybor City National Landmark District with nine distinctive electric streetcars that run along a dedicated rail line. The cars are a mix of refurbished antiques and skillfully crafted replicas. Tickets are free and available at each station. Streetcars are free to ride all day. If you're lucky, you'll catch a mini-concert during your trip.


